AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Transfer of Licenses

FOR the purpose of requiring in Baltimore City that a transfer of any alcoholic beverages license be completed in not more than a certain amount of time after the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City approves the transfer; repealing certain provisions regarding the expiration of a license in Baltimore City; establishing that a license in Baltimore City shall automatically expire under certain circumstances; establishing standards and procedures for extending the date of an automatic expiration of a license; providing that the time period after which certain licenses may be deemed unexpired begins on a certain date; and generally relating to the transfer of alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.
