(F) A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR SERVING ON THE ADVISORY COUNCIL; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(1) MAY CONSULT ON A PRO BONO BASIS WITH EDUCATION AND HEALTH OFFICIALS AND EXPERTS IN THIS STATE AND IN OTHER STATES AND COUNTRIES;

~~(2) SHALL CONVENE ONE OR MORE STATEWIDE OR REGIONAL CONFERENCES ON ATTENTION DEFICIT HYPERACTIVITY DISORDER ON A REGULAR BASIS.~~
