- (M) (1) "PRACTICE SOCIAL WORK" MEANS TO APPLY THE THEORIES, KNOWLEDGE, PROCEDURES, METHODS, OR ETHICS DERIVED FROM A FORMAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM IN SOCIAL WORK TO RESTORE OR ENHANCE SOCIAL OR BIOPSYCHOSOCIAL FUNCTIONING OF INDIVIDUALS, COUPLES, FAMILIES, GROUPS, ORGANIZATIONS, OR COMMUNITIES THROUGH:
