AN ACT concerning

**Alcoholic Beverages - Hard Cider**

FOR the purpose of ~~expanding the definition of beer for certain purposes to include hard cider; specifying a certain alcohol content and certain other ingredient of hard cider; making stylistic changes~~ providing that hard cider shall be considered as beer for certain purposes; defining a certain term; and generally relating to hard cider.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
