- (ii) Regulations governing sewer cleaning, under authority of \S 3-301 of this article;
- (iii) Regulations governing plumbing, under authority of §§ 8-104, 9-101, 14-102, and 15-104 of this article; and
- (iv) Regulations governing [gasfitting] GAS FITTING, under authority of $\S 9-102$ of this article.
- (c) (1) Any person who violates any provision of the regulations is guilty of a WSSC infraction, and, upon delivery of a citation by the WSSC under subsection (d)(1) of this section, shall pay to WSSC a civil monetary fine in the amount set forth in [subsection (c)(3)] PARAGRAPH (3) of this [section] SUBSECTION.
- (2) Each day that a violation remains uncorrected is a separate WSSC infraction subject to an additional citation and fine in the amount set forth in [subsection (c)(3)] PARAGRAPH (3) of this [section] SUBSECTION.
