Charter Amendment Resolution No. 1999-01

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of The Town of Sykesville to amend the Charter of The Town of Sykesville (Section 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County, 1976 Edition, as amended), by amending Section 18-31, entitled "Nominations", and repealing and re-enacting, with amendments Section 18-36, entitled "Vote count", to add provisions with respect to elections of the Mayor and Town Council members, in particular, inserting provisions regarding (i) date of nominations; (ii) acceptance of nominations by candidates; (iii) tie votes in an election; and (iv) prohibition against a candidate holding dual offices.
