RESOLUTION for the enlargement of the corporate boundaries of the Town of Vienna by extending the corporate limits of the Town of Vienna as provided in Section 22-2, entitled "Corporate Boundaries" of the Charter of the Town of Vienna; to provide for the annexation of 1.200 acres of land, more or less, "generally beginning for the outlines of the same at a point on the southward side of Old Route 50, said beginning point being on the State Roads Commission Right of Way Line where said Right of Way Line intersects the Westward edge of a 30 foot wide street, hereinafter identified, and from thence (1) running with and binding the Westward edge of a right of way, or 30 foot wide street, which is shown on a plat entitled "Higgins Addition To Vienna", and which is sometimes referred to as Dorchester Avenue, South 38 degrees 30
