**Bill No. 44-99**

AN ACT concerning:

**Off-duty Uniformed Police Officers and Deputy Sheriffs - Employment - Permits**

FOR the purpose of requiring a person to receive a permit prior to employing off-duty police officers and deputy sheriffs under certain circumstances; establishing certain permit requirements; requiring the Chief of Police to examine the applications; authorizing the Chief to conduct certain investigations; authorizing the Police Department to issue and renew permits and deny and revoke permits under certain circumstances; establishing the scope of the permit; authorizing the Department to adopt certain regulations; establishing certain penalties; repealing certain provisions relating to certain permits; and generally relating to permits for the employment of off-duty police officers and deputy sheriffs.

**Bill No. 45-99**

AN ACT concerning:

**Taxation - Neighborhood Preservation and Stabilization Credit**

FOR the purpose of requiring an individual to apply for the property tax credit within a certain period of time; repealing certain provisions concerning the availability of the property tax credit; and generally relating to the neighborhood preservation and stabilization credit.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments
