Water and Sewer Plan, of Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 256, Water and Sewers, of the Harford County Code, as amended, to provide for the adoption of an amendment to the Spring, 1999 Master Water and Sewer Plan.

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Article XXVII D, Harford County Cultural Advisory Board, of Part 3, Authoritative Boards and Commissions, of Chapter 9, Boards, Commissions, Councils and Agencies, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to rename the Harford County Cultural Advisory Board; and generally relating to the Harford County Cultural Advisory Board.

AN ACT to repeal and reenact with amendments Subsection J of Section 256-13, Water and Sewer Plan, of Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 256, Water and Sewers, of the Harford County Code, as amended, to provide for the adoption of the Fall, 1999 Master Water and Sewer Plan and to submit said Plan to the Maryland Department of the Environment for its approval and implementation pursuant to Title 9 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Annotated Code.

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection A(5), Open Space, Land Preservation and Recreation Plan, of Section 169-1, Adoption; legal status, of Chapter 169, Master Plan, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for the adoption of the 1999 Land Preservation and Recreation Plan as part of the Master Plan; and to further provide that a copy of said 1999 Land Preservation and Recreation Plan, along with all appendices, is attached to this Act and made a part hereof as though it were fully stated herein.

Bill No. 99-58

AN ACT to add new Subsection D to Section 244-5, Handicapped parking, of Article I, General Provisions; and to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 244-20, Parking fines, of Article IV, Citations and Penalties, all of Chapter 244, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to establish a certain prohibition concerning parking in certain areas designed for the use of individuals with disabilities; to establish fines for certain parking violations; and generally relating to parking.
