**Bill No. 17-1999**

AN ACT clarifying that the duties and responsibilities of the Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks include the setting of fees for programs, which may include the establishment of a procedure for payment of a reduced fee based upon a participant's financial ability to pay.

**Bill No. 18-1999**

AN ACT altering the maximum rate the County Council may impose when the Council levies the Fire and Rescue Tax; and making a technical change.

**Bill No. 25-1999**

AN ACT altering the procedure for establishing a rate of pay upon promotion of an employee within the Merit System; and correcting the list of Executive Exempt employees under the Howard County human resources system.

**Bill No. 26-1999**

AN ACT amending the Howard County Retirement Plan; altering the benefit paid to certain employees after certain dates; altering the conditions and procedures for transfer of credited service; making technical changes; altering certain definitions; and generally relating to amendments to the Howard County Retirement Plan.
