Chapter 9

Laws of Montgomery County, 1999

AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

(1) require certain notice to the President of the County Council when the County Executive declares a state of emergency;

(2) amend the period during which a state of emergency is effective without Council action;

(3) require certain notification and reports by the Executive to the Council during and after certain emergency situations; and

[(2)] (4) clarify and modernize the provisions of law governing declarations of emergency.

Chapter 10

Laws of Montgomery County, 1999

AN ACT to:

(1) provide for an animal shelter program;

(2) prohibit cruelty toward animals;

(3) require licensing of certain domestic animals;

(4) protect the public from dangerous animals and public nuisances caused by animals;

(5) control rabies;

(6) adjudicate certain disputes involving animals;

(7) [[establish]] require standards for [[animal care]] County enforcement of State anti-cruelty and other animal control laws; and
