Bill No. 740, 1999 Legislative Session

A BILL ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO CREATE THE TALBOT COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES MANAGEMENT ADVISORY BOARD, TO DEFINE ITS COMPOSITION, OFFICERS AND MEMBERSHIP, INCLUDING THEIR TERMS AND COMPENSATION, AND TO DEFINE ITS POWERS AND FUNCTIONS."

Bill No. 741, 1999 Legislative Session

A BILL TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT SECTION 19.14(b)(7), TITLE 19. ZONING, OF THE TALBOT COUNTY CODE, WITH AMENDMENTS TO ALLOW THE BOARD OF APPEALS TO MAKE REASONABLE ACCOMMODATION FOR DISABLED CITIZENS, TO ESTABLISH CRITERIA FOR DOING SO, AND FOR LIMITING THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT OF ANY SUCH ACCOMMODATION IN THE CRITICAL AREA.

A BILL TO AMEND TALBOT COUNTY CODE, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 2-4(d)(1) TO PERMIT THE HOLDER OF A CLASS "C" BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSE TO ALSO HOLD A CLASS "4" LIMITED WINERY LICENSE AS OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 2B OF THE MARYLAND CODE.

Bill No. 751, 1999 Legislative Session

A BILL TO AMEND TITLE 19, ZONING OF THE TALBOT COUNTY CODE BY REPEALING SECTIONS 19.14(e) AND 19.14(f); RESERVING SAID SECTIONS FOR FUTURE USE; AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 19.15 ENTITLED ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 225 of the Wicomico County Code, titled "Zoning," by the addition of Section 225-101.1, entitled "Telecommunication Antennas," to permit co-location of private telecommunication antennas on existing towers owned by governmental entities.
