

[(2)](II) owns or controls and dedicates at least 1 million gallons of storage capacity in the State to gasoline, other than aviation gasoline, and to special fuel; and

[(3)](III) keeps in the State an inventory of at least 500,000 gallons of that gasoline and special fuel; OR

(2) AN ENTITY THAT IS WHOLLY OWNED BY ONE OR MORE ENTITIES THAT WOULD OTHERWISE QUALIFY AS A CLASS "A" LICENSEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

## CHAPTER 106

### (House Bill 154)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Assisted Suicide - Definition of "Licensed Health Care Professional"**

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "licensed health care professional" to include emergency medical services providers in order to make certain provisions that exclude a licensed health care professional from criminal liability for performing certain activities applicable to emergency medical services providers; providing for the application of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to emergency medical services providers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
