

contained in this article, but not inconsistent therewith, as in their judgment would give the municipality more effective control of each of the places of business.

(3) In addition to the powers given to the Board in subsection (a) of this section, the Board may employ one part-time chief inspector at an annual salary of \$8,000, and [12] 16 part-time inspectors at an annual salary of \$5,000 each. In addition to this salary, each of the inspectors shall receive a monthly expense of \$150 per month, subject to the approval of the State Comptroller.

(4) The [13] 17 inspectors shall:

(i) Have all the powers of a peace officer or a constable or sheriff of this State;

(ii) Make oath to faithfully perform the duties entrusted to them, as provided in Article I, § 9 of the Constitution of this State; and

(iii) Furnish bond in the penalty of \$2,000 to the Board and the County Council jointly, conditioned "that inspector shall well and faithfully execute the office in all things appertaining thereto". The cost of the bond shall be paid by the County. The inspectors for Anne Arundel County are known as the "liquor inspectors for Anne Arundel County".

(5) [There is] THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS:

(i) [A full-time administrator to the Board] MAY EMPLOY UP TO TWO FULL-TIME ADMINISTRATORS whose annual [salary] SALARIES shall be fixed by the Board as in a general Anne Arundel County classified salary schedule, within pay grade 16;

(ii) [A] SHALL EMPLOY A full-time secretary [to the Board] whose annual salary shall be fixed by the Board as in a general county classified salary schedule, within pay grade 13; and

(iii) [An] SHALL EMPLOY AN attorney [to the Board,] at an annual salary of \$8,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages - Costs for Violations

FOR the purpose of altering the costs that the Anne Arundel County Board of License
