SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9-321.

The governing body of Somerset County may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against county property tax imposed on real property owned by[:

- (1) the Crisfield Area Chamber of Commerce; or
- (2) the J. Millard Tawes Foundation] THE CRISFIELD HERITAGE FOUNDATION, INC.

Estates and Trusts - Small Estates - Maximum Property Value
