

## Volunteer Fire Company in Somerset County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

The Public Local Laws of Somerset County

Section 2-304(a)

Article 20 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1994 Edition, as amended)

(As enacted by Chapter 482 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 20 - Somerset County**

2-304.

(a) (1) The County Commissioners shall appropriate and levy annually the following amounts for the use of the organized volunteer fire companies in the County:
