(a) A biological parent may file with the [Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene] DIRECTOR OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES a disclosure veto prohibiting the disclosure of any information concerning that parent that is contained in a record described in § 5-3A-02 of this subtitle.

(b) An adopted individual at least 20 years old may file with the [Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene] DIRECTOR OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES a disclosure veto prohibiting the disclosure of any information concerning that individual that is contained in a record described in § 5-3A-02 of this subtitle.

(C) THE DIRECTOR OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL IMMEDIATELY FORWARD A COPY OF A DISCLOSURE VETO FILED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) OF THIS SECTION TO THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

[(c)] (D) An individual authorized to file a disclosure veto under subsection (a) or (b) of this section may cancel or refile a disclosure veto at any time.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2000.

(House Bill 1408)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery County - Old Town Takoma Park Loan of 1998
