~~(3) Further provided that \$1,000,000 of this appropriation may not be expended until the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra (BSO) and the Baltimore Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. (or their contractor who will manage and operate the Hippodrome Performing Arts Center) enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). This MOU should outline a comprehensive plan to foster cooperation between the BSO and the Hippodrome Performing Arts Center. The strategy should ensure that the BSO's existing business base will be recognized, to the extent practicable and as permitted by federal and State law. The Board of Directors of the Baltimore Center for the Performing Arts, Inc. shall report to the budget committees on or before July 1, 2000, on the progress of the MOU.~~
