DE02.01 Public Works Capital Appropriation

General Fund Appropriation, *provided that it is the intent of the General Assembly that the new arena at the University of Maryland, College Park not exceed 470,000 gross square feet.*

Further provided that \$9,820,000 of this appropriation, made for the purpose of constructing Bowie State University's "New Science Building" may not be expended until:

- (1) *the budget committees have received a report from the Department of Budget and Management indicating that current enrollment projections for Bowie State University continue to justify the need for a new science building which includes:*
 - (a) *revised enrollment projections for fiscal 2001 through fiscal 2010;*
 - (b) *revised enrollment projections for each of the programs to be housed in the new science building for fiscal 2001 through fiscal 2010;*
 - (c) *a detailed plan prepared by Bowie State University which addresses how the university will achieve increased enrollment consistent with its enrollment projections*
