If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 2003, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in Section 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article. The proceeds of any amount of the loan in excess of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall also be applied to the purposes authorized in Section 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
