2-111.

(a) [(1) The Commission shall maintain testing equipment to calibrate the master standard watt-hour meters that are used by public service companies furnishing electricity.

(2) A public service company that uses the testing equipment shall pay to the Commission the fees that the Commission sets by order.

(3) In setting the fees, the Commission shall consider the estimated expenses associated with maintaining the testing equipment.

(b)] The Commission may charge reasonable fees for copies of Commission documents:

[(c)] (B) The Commission may charge \$1 to issue or renew a taxicab driver license and \$2 to issue a duplicate taxicab driver license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

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**CHAPTER 117**

**(Senate Bill 49)**

AN ACT concerning

**Public Service Commission - Liquefied Petroleum Gas**

FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law pertaining solely to public service companies providing liquefied petroleum gas pursuant to franchises that existed on or before a certain date; clarifying that owners of gas service installations must comply with certain metering requirements; clarifying that consumers of gas service may request an inspection and test of the meter; and generally relating to the Commission's jurisdiction over liquefied petroleum gas.
