

(2) the number of customers or dwelling units furnished service at each location; and

(3) the name and address of the office responsible for the service.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

**CHAPTER 118**

**(Senate Bill 53)**

AN ACT concerning

**Mass Transit Administration - Prohibited Acts - Issuance of Citations**

FOR the purpose of requiring a person who engages in certain prohibited acts in a transit vehicle or transit facility under the jurisdiction of the Mass Transit Administration, on request of a police officer or other authorized agent, to provide certain proof of identity; authorizing police officers and authorized agents of the Administration to issue citations for certain prohibited acts occurring in transit vehicles or transit facilities under certain circumstances; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to enforcement of certain provisions prohibiting certain acts in Mass Transit Administration vehicles and facilities.
