(a) On filing an application for a new license or for reinstatement of [his] THE privilege to drive, any individual whose license or privilege to drive has been revoked, shall pay to the Administration a fee established by the Administration.

(b) [(1) If the new license or reinstatement is granted, subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection, the applicant shall pay to the Administration, in addition to any other fees provided by law, an additional fee established by the Administration.

(2)] If the applicant's license was revoked as a result of a conviction under § 21-902 of this article or a violation of an alcohol restriction, the applicant shall pay a fee established by the Administration in addition to the amount charged under [paragraph (1) of this subsection] SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Transfers - Continued Use of Registration Plates

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
