

- (6) The office of the sheriff of any county or Baltimore City;
- (7) The police department, bureau, or force of any bicounty agency;
- (8) The Maryland Transportation Authority Police and the police forces of the Department of Transportation;
- (9) The police officers of the Department of Natural Resources;
- (10) The Investigative Services Unit of the Comptroller's Office;
- (11) Housing Authority of Baltimore City Police Force;
- (12) The Crofton Police Department;
- (13) The police officers of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- (14) The police officers of the Department of General Services;
- (15) The police officers of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation;
- (16) The State Fire Marshal or a full-time investigative and inspection assistant of the Office of the State Fire Marshal; [or]
- (17) The police officers of the University System of Maryland; OR
- (18) THE POLICE OFFICERS OF MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 139

(Senate Bill 288)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Aging School Program - Qualified Zone Academy Bonds

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$8,270,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Interagency Committee on School Construction for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds and the allocation of funds to eligible school systems, subject to a requirement that the grantee document the provision of a required federal matching fund; authorizing the Board of Public Works to sell certain bonds at certain sales; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
