

TOGETHER WITH EXPENSES FOR THE PROPER PERFORMANCE OF ASSIGNED DUTIES OF THE COURT ADMINISTRATOR AND EMPLOYEES APPOINTED UNDER THIS SECTION.

(C) THE COURT ADMINISTRATOR MAY NOT ENGAGE DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY IN THE PRACTICE OF LAW.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

## CHAPTER 143

### (Senate Bill 324)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Maryland Real Estate Commission - Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation**

FOR the purpose of continuing the Maryland Real Estate Commission in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Commission; altering a provision relating to the subject matter of a certain continuing education course to be approved by the Commission; requiring the Commission to adopt certain regulations to provide for the conduct of continuing education courses by certain methods of transmission on or before a certain date; requiring that an evaluation of the Commission and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Commission be performed on or before a certain date; requiring the Commission to submit a certain report to certain committees on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the Maryland Real Estate Commission.
