Each resident applicant shall pay to the Treasurer of the Board of Electrical Examiners the sum of [thirty-five dollars (\$35.)] FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.), and each nonresident applicant shall pay a fee equal to the fee charged in their county, but not less than [thirty-five dollars (\$35.)] FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.). Each out-of-state applicant shall pay a fee equal to the fee charged in their state, but not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75.) for such license, and provided, further, that every person before receiving a license shall furnish to the Board proof that the person carries general liability and property damage insurance in the amounts required by Article 56, § 535(D), of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

A Each [and every] license issued under the provisions of this chapter shall be evidence in any court of Cecil County of the business for which the license IS issued for a period not to exceed one (1) year from the date hereof. All licenses [and renewals of same] shall expire on the first day of May in each year.

B. ISSUANCE OF ANY SUBSEQUENT LICENSE AFTER THE INITIAL LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS CHAPTER IS SUBJECT TO PAYMENT OF THE APPLICATION FEE ESTABLISHED UNDER § 99–14 OF THIS CHAPTER AND EVIDENCE OF SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF CONTINUING EDUCATION AS REQUIRED AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

CHAPTER 145

(Senate Bill 348)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Howard County - Norbel School

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$375,000 \$352,500, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of Norbel School Norbel School, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Howard County – Norbel School Loan of 2001 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of
