- (a) [Subject] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AND SUBJECT to the provisions of subsection [(c)] (D) of this section, a person who violates any provision of this Part V of this subtitle or any rule or regulation adopted under this Part V of this subtitle is subject to a civil penalty imposed in a civil action not exceeding \$1,000 for each violation.
- (B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 5–552 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND IS SERVED A CIVIL CITATION UNDER THAT SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY AS FOLLOWS:
 - (I) \$250 FOR THE FIRST VIOLATION;
 - (II) \$500 FOR THE SECOND VIOLATION; AND
 - (III) \$1,000 FOR THE THIRD AND EACH SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION.
- (2) ANY MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- (3) ANY PERSON SERVED WITH A CITATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY APPEAL THE CITATION TO THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH \S 10–205 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
