SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

5-216.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PILOT PROGRAM" MEANS THE MARYLAND EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY SUMMER PILOT PROGRAM.
- (B) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES TO BALTIMORE COUNTY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- $\frac{(\mathbf{E})}{\mathbf{E}}$ $\frac{(\mathbf{C})}{\mathbf{C}}$ THERE IS A MARYLAND EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY SUMMER PILOT PROGRAM TO ENRICH STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12 BY THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM AND ACTIVITIES IN THE SUMMER MONTHS.
- $\frac{\langle C \rangle}{\langle D \rangle}$ (1) The PILOT PROGRAM SHALL BE ADMINISTERED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION.
- (2) (I) A COUNTY BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE LOCAL EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION, MAY DEVELOP A PROPOSAL FOR EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM AND ACTIVITIES DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS USING EXISTING FACULTY.
- (II) A COUNTY BOARD MAY FORWARD A PROPOSAL TO THE STATE BOARD BY AUGUST 15 OF EACH YEAR.
 - (3) THE STATE BOARD:
- (I) SHALL REVIEW A PROPOSAL OF A COUNTY BOARD BY OCTOBER 15 OF EACH YEAR:
- (II) MAY MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS THAT IT DEEMS NECESSARY; AND
- (III) SHALL SELECT A PROPOSAL FOR IMPLEMENTATION BY NOVEMBER 15 OF EACH YEAR, GIVING PRIORITY TO:
 - 1. PROPOSALS FOR DIVERSE AREAS OF THE STATE; AND
- 2. PROPOSALS FOR SCHOOLS THAT SHOW THE LOWEST LEVELS OF IMPROVEMENT TOWARDS MEETING THE STANDARDS OF THE MARYLAND SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PROGRAM.
- (4) AFTER THE STATE BOARD SELECTS A PROPOSAL OF A COUNTY BOARD, THE STATE BOARD SHALL DISTRIBUTE TO A COUNTY BOARD FUNDS TO COVER THE COST OF EXTENDING THE CONTRACTS OF PARTICIPATING TEACHERS TO IMPLEMENT AND OPERATE THE \underline{PIL} OT PROGRAM.
