- (l) "Registration" means a registration issued by the Director authorizing an individual to operate a cemetery or to provide burial goods.
- (m) "Registered cemeterian" means an individual registered to operate a cemetery as a sole proprietor or on behalf of a SOLE PROPRIETOR OR OF A permit holder.
- (n) "Registered seller" means an individual registered to provide burial goods as a sole proprietor or on behalf of a SOLE PROPRIETOR OR OF A permit holder.
- (O) "RESPONSIBLE PARTY" MEANS A SOLE PROPRIETOR OR THE INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY A PARTNERSHIP, LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, OR CORPORATION TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OPERATIONS OF A CEMETERY OR BURIAL GOODS BUSINESS.

5-102.

- (a) The registration and permitting provisions of this title do not apply to:
- (1) a person that owns and operates a bona fide religious, nonprofit cemetery in this State; [or]
- (2) a not for profit organization created before 1900 by an act of the General Assembly;
- (3) A COUNTY, CITY, OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT OWNS AND OPERATES A CEMETERY IN THE STATE; OR
 - (4) A VETERANS' CEMETERY OPERATED BY THE STATE
 - (b) This title does not apply to:
- (1) the operation of a funeral establishment, including the sale of burial goods in the ordinary course of the funeral establishment's business;
- (2) a licensed funeral director acting within the scope of the funeral director's license; or
- (3) a mortician acting within the scope of the mortician's license. 5-303.
 - (a) An applicant shall register by:
- (1) submitting to the Director an application on the form that the Director provides; and
 - (2) paying a nonrefundable application fee set by the Director.
 - (b) The application shall state:
 - (1) the name, date of birth, and residential address of the applicant;
- (2) the name and fixed address of the affiliated cemetery or burial goods business:
