

(9) an individual who is licensed or otherwise authorized to practice land surveying under Title 15 of this article to practice land surveying or to perform landscape architecture services incidentally to practicing land surveying;

(10) an employee of an individual authorized to practice land surveying under Title 15 of this article to perform landscape architecture services under the supervision of the individual and incidentally to practicing land surveying; or

(11)] a nurseryman, general contractor, or landscape contractor to design, plan, locate, plant, or arrange plantings or other ornamental features.

14-101.

(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) "Board" means the State Board for Professional Engineers.

(c) ["Engineer" means an individual who practices engineering] "DESIGN COORDINATION" MEANS THE REVIEW AND COORDINATION OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY INDIVIDUALS LICENSED OR CERTIFIED UNDER TITLES 3, 8, 9, 14, AND 15 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(d) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board to practice engineering.

(2) "License" includes, unless the context requires otherwise, a limited license.

(e) "Limited license" means a license issued by the Board to practice engineering as limited by § 14-316 of this title.

(f) (1) "Practice engineering" means to provide any service or creative work the performance of which requires education, training, and experience in the application of:

(i) special knowledge of the mathematical, physical, and engineering sciences; and

(ii) the principles and methods of engineering analysis and design.

(2) In regard to a building or other structure, machine, equipment, process, works, system, project, or public or private utility, "practice engineering" includes:

(i) consultation;

(ii) design;

(iii) evaluation;

(iv) inspection of construction to ensure compliance with specifications and drawings;

(v) investigation; [and]
