AN ACT concerning

**Criminal Procedure - Arrest Without Warrants - Department of Labor,
Licensing, and Regulation Police Force**

FOR the purpose of adding a member of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation Police Force to the definition of "police officer" under the law relating to arrests without warrants; and generally relating to the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation Police Force.

**SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:**

Article - Criminal Procedure

(c) "Police officer" means a person who in an official capacity is authorized by law to make arrests and is:

- (1) a member of the Department of State Police;
- (2) a member of the Police Department of Baltimore City;
- (3) a member of the Baltimore City School Police Force;
- (4) a member of the police department, bureau, or force of a county;
- (5) a member of the police department, bureau, or force of a municipal corporation;
