

(2) is serving as a member of the militia ordered into active service by the Governor under Article 65, § 8 of the Code; or

(3) is a member of the armed forces of the United States under orders to aid civil authorities of the State in enforcing law and order, subject to subsection (c) of this section.

(c) The grant of authority under subsection (b)(3) of this section does not limit or impair any power or duty of a member of the armed forces of the United States or authorize any action incompatible with federal law or regulations.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 207

(House Bill 258)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - County Treasurer

FOR the purpose of abolishing the elected position of County Treasurer of Frederick County; requiring that the County Treasurer of Frederick County be a regular county employee; repealing a certain provision setting the annual salary of the County Treasurer; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent County Treasurer of Frederick County; and generally relating to the County Treasurer of Frederick County.
