

PROGRAM MANAGER OF THE DEPARTMENT and witnessed by a notary public that authorizes the confidential intermediary to obtain information necessary to locate an individual sought by an applicant.

(3) If a confidential intermediary complies with paragraph (2) of this subsection, a custodian shall permit inspection of a public record requested under this subsection by the confidential intermediary.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

**CHAPTER 214**

**(House Bill 348)**

AN ACT concerning

**Charles County - Salaries - Judges of the Orphans' Court**

FOR the purpose of altering the salary for judges of the Orphans' Court of Charles County; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent judges.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Estates and Trusts**

2-108.

(j) (1) The salary for each judge of the Court for Charles County is:

(i) [\$6,000 for the calendar year 1994;

(ii) \$6,180 for the calendar year 1995; and

(iii)] \$6,365 for calendar years [1996, 1997, and 1998] 2001 AND 2002;

AND

(II) \$7,000 PER YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2003 AND EACH SUBSEQUENT CALENDAR YEAR.
