- (18) an entry of an appeal to an appellate court;
- (19) a judgment of an appellate court;
- (20) an order of a court in a collateral proceeding that affects a person's conviction, sentence, or confinement;
  - (21) an adjudication of a child as delinquent:
- (i) if the child is at least 14 years old, for an act described in § 3-804(e)(1) of the Courts Article; or
- (ii) if the child is at least 16 years old, for an act described in § 3-804(e)(4) or (5) of the Courts Article;
- (22) the issuance or withdrawal of a writ of attachment by a juvenile court; and
- (23) any other event arising out of or occurring during the course of a criminal proceeding that the Secretary by regulation or the Court of Appeals by rule makes a reportable event.

## 10-219.

- (A) Except in accordance with applicable federal law and regulations, a criminal justice unit and the Central Repository may not disseminate criminal history record information.
- (B) (1) THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL DISSEMINATE ON A MONTHLY BASIS INFORMATION CONCERNING A CHILD CHARGED AS AN ADULT TO THE MARYLAND JUSTICE ANALYSIS CENTER OF THE INSTITUTE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND CRIMINOLOGY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.
- (2) IN ADDITION TO ANY REPORTABLE EVENT, AS DEFINED IN  $\S$  10–215 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY SHALL INCLUDE IN ITS DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION TO THE MARYLAND JUSTICE ANALYSIS CENTER THE AGE, RACE, AND GENDER OF THE CHILD.
- (3) THE CENTRAL REPOSITORY MAY NOT DISSEMINATE TO THE MARYLAND JUSTICE ANALYSIS CENTER ANY UNIQUE IDENTIFIERS RELATING TO THE CHILD, INCLUDING THE NAME OF THE CHILD, FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS, AND RECORD OR FILE NUMBERS.
- (4) THE INFORMATION DISSEMINATED TO THE MARYLAND JUSTICE ANALYSIS CENTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES OF RESEARCH, EVALUATION, AND STATISTICAL ANALYSIS.
- (5) BY JUNE 30 AND DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE MARYLAND JUSTICE ANALYSIS CENTER SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, AND, SUBJECT TO § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ON THE RESULTS OF ITS RESEARCH, EVALUATION, AND STATISTICAL ANALYSIS.
