SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (2) "Grant" means the Health [Manpower] PERSONNEL Shortage Incentive Grant for eligible institutions offering educational programs leading to licensure, certification, or registration in health occupations determined to be in short supply.
- (b) (1) There is a Health Manpower PERSONNEL Shortage Incentive Grant Program for eligible institutions.
