(House Bill 462)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Health ~~Manpower~~ Personnel Shortage Incentive Grant Program - Grants

FOR the purpose of altering the method of determining under the Health ~~Manpower~~ Personnel Shortage Incentive Grant Program the threshold number of graduating students from certain institutions above which the institutions shall receive from the State Scholarship Administration certain grants per graduating student; and generally relating to grants under the Health ~~Manpower~~ Personnel Shortage Incentive Grant Program.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-803.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) "Grant" means the Health ~~Manpower~~ PERSONNEL Shortage Incentive Grant for eligible institutions offering educational programs leading to licensure, certification, or registration in health occupations determined to be in short supply.

(b) (1) There is a Health ~~Manpower~~ PERSONNEL Shortage Incentive Grant Program for eligible institutions.
