AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - County Commissioners - Building Excise Tax

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Calvert County to fix and impose, by ordinance, a building excise tax on all types of building construction; requiring the County Commissioners to specify in the ordinance the ~~type~~ types of building construction subject to the tax; authorizing the County Commissioners to impose different rates of the building excise tax on different types of building construction subject to the tax; requiring that the revenues from the building excise tax be deposited in the County's general fund; authorizing the County Commissioners to use the revenues from the building excise tax for any lawful purpose; repealing certain authority for the County Commissioners of Calvert County to impose development impact fees; and generally relating to authorizing the County Commissioners of Calvert County to impose a building excise tax.
