- [(4)] (5) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- [(5)] (6) A member who serves 2 consecutive full 4-year terms may not be reappointed for 4 years after the completion of those terms.
- [(6)] (7) If a vacancy occurs, the Governor promptly shall appoint a successor.

## 13 - 204.

- (a) The members present at a meeting are a quorum to do business.
- (b) The Advisory Council shall meet at least twice a year, at the times and places that it determines.
  - (c) A member of the Advisory Council:
    - (1) May not receive compensation; but
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (d) The Secretary shall designate the staff necessary to carry out this subtitle. 13-205.

## The Advisory Council:

- (1) Shall develop and promote educational programs in the prevention, <u>EARLY DETECTION</u>, and treatment of high blood pressure and related cardiovascular risk factors HEART DISEASE AND STROKE, TARGETED TO HIGH-RISK POPULATIONS AND TO GEOGRAPHIC AREAS WHERE THERE IS A HIGH INCIDENCE OF HEART DISEASE AND STROKE; **!** and **!**
- (2) SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A COMPREHENSIVE STATEWIDE PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM ON STROKE PREVENTION, TARGETED TO HIGH-RISK POPULATIONS AND TO GEOGRAPHIC AREAS WHERE THERE IS A HIGH INCIDENCE OF STROKE, INCLUDING INFORMATION DEVELOPED OR COMPILED BY THE COUNCIL ON ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- (I) HEALTH-LIFESTYLE PRACTICES THAT REDUCE THE RISK OF STROKE;
- (II) SICNS AND SYMPTOMS OF STROKE AND ACTION TO BE TAKEN WHEN SICNS OCCUR:
- (III) DETERMINANTS OF HIGH QUALITY HEALTH CARE FOR STROKE:
- (IV) OTHER INFORMATION THE COUNCIL CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE FOR INCLUSION IN THE PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM; AND
  - (2) May use existing programs and groups for this purpose.
