

~~(6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest:~~

~~(i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;~~
and

~~(ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.~~

~~(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2001.

AN ACT concerning

**Criminal Procedure - Registration of Offenders and Sex Offenders -
Required Disclosures**

FOR the purpose of requiring a local law enforcement agency on written request to send, under certain circumstances, a copy of the registration statement for each sexually violent offender or offender whose registration statement is on record with the law enforcement agency to the person who submitted the request; and generally relating to disclosure of registration statements of offenders and sex offenders.
