Article – Business Occupations and Professions

Section 5-318

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2000 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

5-101.

(g) (1) “License” means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board.

(2) “License” includes, unless the context requires otherwise, each of the following licenses:

- (i) a license to practice cosmetology;
- (ii) a license to practice as a senior cosmetologist;
- (iii) a limited license to provide makeup artist services;
- (iv) a limited license to provide esthetic services; [and]
- (v) a limited license to provide nail technician services; AND
- (VI) A TEMPORARY LICENSE.

(b) (1) Subject to paragraph (4) of this subsection, the Board shall establish reasonable fees for examinations, reinstatements, certifications, applications, preopening inspections, per diem fees for Board members, compensation for inspectors appointed by the Board, and for any other service performed by the Board necessary to carry out the provisions of this title.

(2) Except for the examination fees which the Board shall establish in amounts not to exceed the costs of the examinations, the fees established by the Board shall be set in a manner that will produce funds sufficient to cover the actual direct and indirect costs of regulating the cosmetology industry in the State in accordance with the provisions of this title.

(3) The total cost of regulating the cosmetology industry in the State in accordance with the provisions of this title may not be more than the revenues generated by the fees established under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(4) [The] SUBJECT TO § 5-318(F) OF THIS TITLE, THE Board shall require a \$25 fee for the licensure or renewal of licensure of cosmetologists, senior cosmetologists, estheticians, nail technicians, and makeup artists.
