5-318.

- (A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS WAITING TO TAKE A LICENSING EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- (B) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE ONLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- (1) EXCEPT FOR TAKING AND PASSING AN EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY;
- $\,$ (2) $\,$ SUBMITS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES; AND
- (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5 205 OF THIS TITLE OF \$10.
- (C) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE AT THE TIME THE APPLICANT RECEIVES NOTICE OF THE RELEVANT EXAMINATION DATE.
- (D) WHILE A TEMPORARY LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST.
 - (E) A TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE EARLIER OF:
 - (1) 120 DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE TEMPORARY LICENSE;
- (2) THE FAILURE OF THE HOLDER OF THE TEMPORARY LICENSE TO TAKE A SCHEDULED EXAMINATION WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE ISSUANCE OF THE TEMPORARY LICENSE;
- (3) NOTICE BY THE BOARD THAT THE APPLICANT HAS FAILED THE EXAMINATION, OR
- (4) ISSUANCE UNDER THIS TITLE OF A LICENSE TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY OR A LIMITED LICENSE.
- (F) THE BOARD SHALL CREDIT THE AMOUNT OF THE APPLICATION FEE PAID BY AN APPLICANT UNDER THIS SECTION TOWARD THE INITIAL LICENSE FEE REQUIRED OF THE APPLICANT UNDER § 5–205(B) OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
