

Allegany County and of a municipal corporation in Allegany County may grant, by law, a property tax credit against the county and municipal corporation property tax imposed on any property within:

(I) the area known as the Riverside Industrial Park;

~~(II)~~ (II) A COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL PARK OWNED, MANAGED, OR OPERATED BY THE ALLEGANY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; OR

~~(III)~~ (III) A PUBLIC INDUSTRIAL PARK OWNED, MANAGED, OR OPERATED BY A FOUNDATION UNDER AN ORGANIZATION DESCRIBED IN § 501(C)(6) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

(2) IN AUTHORIZING A CREDIT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) (II) OR (III) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION MAY PROVIDE, BY LAW, FOR:

(I) THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT; AND

(II) ANY OTHER PROVISION NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER THE CREDIT.

~~(2)~~ (3) A tax credit granted under this subsection may not be granted for more than 10 years.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October 1, 2001.~~ June 1, 2001 and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 2001.

AN ACT concerning

Mental Hygiene Law - Advance Directives

FOR the purpose of requiring that an administrative head of a residential facility providing treatment or services to individuals with mental disorders who releases an individual from the facility notify the individual of the advisability of ~~developing~~ making an advance directive for mental health services; requiring that the facility assist the individual in ~~developing~~ making the advance directive if the individual requests assistance or refer the individual to an appropriate community resource for assistance in ~~developing~~ making an advance directive; requiring the administrative head of the facility, when referring an individual to a community resource, to notify the community resource of certain information that is not confidential; providing for the making of an advance directive to govern the provision of mental health services; specifying the procedures applicable to the making and revocation of an advance directive for mental
