- (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey to the Maryland-Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest:
- (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.
- (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 270

(House Bill 770)

AN ACT concerning

Mental Hygiene - Emergency Evaluation - Clinical Social Worker

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

10-601.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED UNDER TITLE 19 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE TO PRACTICE CLINICAL SOCIAL WORK.
- (C) "Physician" means an individual who is licensed under Title 14 of the Health Occupations Article to practice medicine in this State.
