THIS SECTION ARE ON A BOAT, IF AT LEAST ONE INDIVIDUAL ON A BOAT IS LICENSED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(2) OF THIS SECTION, OR IF THE BOAT IS LICENSED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(3) OF THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING LIMITS ON GEAR APPLY TO THE BOAT:

- (I) ONE TROTLINE GEAR THAT MAY NOT EXCEED $\frac{1,000}{1,200}$ FEET IN LENGTH FOR THE BAITED PORTION; AND
- (II) 1. NOT MORE THAN $\frac{20}{20}$ COLLAPSIBLE TRAPS OR NET RINGS; OR
- 2. NOT MORE THAN $\frac{20}{20}$ OF A COMBINATION OF COLLAPSIBLE TRAPS AND NET RINGS;
 - (III) HANDLINES, DIPNETS, SEINES; AND
- (H) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT SET GEAR TO CATCH CRABS FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES UNTIL AT LEAST ONE-HALF HOUR AFTER THE WORK DAY BEGINS FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO CRAB FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.
- (3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION AND WHO OWNS PRIVATE PROPERTY ALONG THE SHORE:
- (I) MAY NOT SET MORE THAN 2 CRAB POTS FROM THE INDIVIDUAL'S PROPERTY; AND
- (II) SHALL DISPLAY THE INDIVIDUAL'S LICENSE NUMBER, WITH CHARACTERS NOT LESS THAN 2 INCHES HIGH, ON A SIGN AFFIXED TO A POLE OR PIER ATTACHED TO THE INDIVIDUAL'S PROPERTY.
- [(g)] (H) (J) (1) An individual who may catch or attempt to catch crabs under this section may not offer to sell or sell crabs that were caught for [noncommercial or] recreational purposes.
- (2) [A person] AN INDIVIDUAL may not knowingly buy or offer to buy crabs from [an] ANOTHER individual who caught crabs for [noncommercial] RECREATIONAL purposes under this section.
- [(h)] (H) (K) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, [a person] AN INDIVIDUAL who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:
 - (i) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$500; and
 - (ii) For a second or subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$1,000.
