

**CHAPTER 278**

**(House Bill 874)**

AN ACT concerning

**Crimes - Driving While License Revoked - Penalties**

FOR the purpose of ~~requiring~~ authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration, on receiving notice of a conviction under certain provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law of an individual whose license to drive is revoked, to extend the date before which the individual is not eligible for reinstatement ~~instead of assessing certain points~~ for certain periods under certain circumstances; providing for certain procedures; providing that the Administration may not revoke a license that is currently revoked; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to an extension of a license revocation under certain circumstances for an individual who is convicted of certain offenses while the individual's license to drive is revoked.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Transportation**

11-128.

"License", as used in reference to the operation of a motor vehicle, means any:

- (1) Driver's license; and
- (2) Any other license or permit to drive a motor vehicle that is issued under or granted by the laws of this State, including:
  - (i) Any temporary license;
  - (ii) A learner's instructional permit;
  - (iii) A provisional license;
