

Section 3-108.1(c) and (o)  
 Annotated Code of Maryland  
 (1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

3-108.1.

(c) The Board consists of:

(1) Nine voting members jointly appointed by the Mayor of Baltimore City and the Governor from a list of qualified individuals submitted to the Mayor and the Governor by the State Board; and

(2) One [nonvoting] VOTING student member appointed as provided in subsection (o) of this section.

(o) (1) One student member shall be a student enrolled in the Baltimore City Public School System who shall be selected by the Associated Student Congress of Baltimore City.

(2) The term of a student member is 1 year.

(3) A student member may not serve more than two consecutive full terms.

(4) THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY VOTE ON ALL MATTERS BEFORE THE BOARD EXCEPT THOSE RELATING TO:

(I) PERSONNEL;

(II) CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS;

(III) SCHOOL CLOSINGS, REOPENINGS, AND BOUNDARIES;

(IV) COLLECTIVE BARGAINING DECISIONS;

(V) STUDENT DISCIPLINARY MATTERS; AND

(VI) APPEALS TO THE BOARD AS PROVIDED UNDER §§ 4-205 AND 6-202 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(5) THE STUDENT MEMBER MAY NOT ATTEND OR PARTICIPATE IN AN EXECUTIVE OR SPECIAL SESSION OF THE BOARD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
