

(II) THE SUNDAY AND MONDAY PRECEDE A STATE OR FEDERAL HOLIDAY THAT FALLS ON A TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, OR FRIDAY OF THE PARTICULAR WEEK.

(F) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT IN ITS DISCRETION TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATIVE DAYS OFF FOR A LICENSEE OTHER THAN A SUNDAY OR MONDAY.

(G) THE LICENSED INDIVIDUAL SHALL PAINT OR FIRMLY AFFIX LETTERS TO THE PORT SIDE OF THE VESSEL THAT IS DECLARED UNDER THIS SECTION IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

(1) THE LETTERS SHALL BE POSITIONED IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO BE CLEARLY VISIBLE TO PERSONS IN-PASSING BOATS;

(2) THE LETTERS SHALL BE PLAIN VERTICAL BLOCK CHARACTERS OF NOT LESS THAN 4 INCHES IN HEIGHT AND SHALL CONTRAST WITH THE COLOR OF THE BACKGROUND;

(3) THE LETTERS "SUN" SHALL BE DISPLAYED AS THE ABBREVIATION FOR A SUNDAY DECLARED AS OFF UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(4) THE LETTERS "MON" SHALL BE DISPLAYED AS THE ABBREVIATION FOR A MONDAY DECLARED AS OFF UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001 June 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May 31, 2004, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

**CHAPTER 295**

**(House Bill 1025)**

AN ACT concerning

**Election Law - Baltimore County Republican Party Central Committee**
