

2. The percentage of Baltimore County's population of a legislative district shall be determined by the most recent United States census.]

(2) THE REPUBLICAN PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF:

(I) FOUR MEMBERS ELECTED FROM EACH COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY; AND

(II) A CHAIRMAN ELECTED FROM THE COUNTY AT LARGE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

**CHAPTER 296**

**(House Bill 1029)**

AN ACT concerning

**Task Force to Study the Health Care Needs of Inmates in Transition from Correctional Institutions**

FOR the purpose of extending the time by which the Task Force to Study the Health Care Needs of Inmates in Transition from Correctional Institutions is required to report to the General Assembly; amending Chapter 466 of the Acts of 2000; extending a certain termination date that applies to the Task Force; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study the Health Care Needs of Inmates in Transition from Correctional Institutions.
