SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

~~(B) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION ANNUALLY SHALL USE MONEY APPROPRIATED FROM UNUSED MARYLAND TEACHER SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER § 18-2209 OF THIS ARTICLE TO FUND SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER THIS SECTION.~~~~(2) A STUDENT WHO IS AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT SUBJECT TO THE SERVICE OBLIGATION UNDER TITLE 18, SUBTITLE 22 OF THIS ARTICLE.~~~~18-2201.~~~~(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated:~~~~(b) "Eligible institution" means a public or private institution of higher education in this State that possesses a certificate of approval from the Maryland Higher Education Commission.~~~~(c) (1) "Service obligation" means to teach full time in the State as a teacher in a Maryland public elementary or secondary school.~~~~(2) "Service obligation" does not mean employment as teaching assistants, volunteer service, paid fellowships, or internships.~~~~(d) "Administration" means the State Scholarship Administration as defined in § 18-101(b) of this title.~~
