(a) In this section, "part-time student" means a student [enrolled] WHO IS:

- (1) ENROLLED in a degree-granting program at an eligible institution and taking at least 6 but no more than 11 semester hours of courses each semester; OR
- (2) DUALY ENROLLED IN A SECONDARY SCHOOL IN THE STATE AND AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

(b) (1) In cooperation with the institutions of higher education in the State, the Commission shall establish and administer a grant program for undergraduate part-time students.

(2) EACH INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT PARTICIPATES IN THE GRANT PROGRAM SHALL ESTABLISH CRITERIA FOR AWARDING A GRANT OR WAIVER TO DUALY ENROLLED STUDENTS.

(c) A recipient of a part-time grant shall:

- (1) Be a resident of the State; and
- (2) (I) Have demonstrated a definite financial need according to criteria established by the Commission; OR
- (II) BE A DUALY ENROLLED STUDENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
